

Communication


You will be notified of your registration by email. Once you log in you will see the following




At this point you can reach out to a person by asking to "friend" them or sending them a message through the links below their names/icons.

You can communicate with a person or a group. The intent of these groups is to

- (a) Combine people on a specific project which will be dissolved at the end of the project
- (b) Create a group that will be used for an indefinite period for a variety of purposes, for example focused on an open-ended collaboration with another group




During group creation the creator will see this menu that determines the type of group and who can invite additional users.



We ask that users use and create groups judiciously since it is easy to create groups and lose track of their function!

It is also possible to create a forum associated with the created group - containing a discussion around a specific topic in one place.




It is possible to add media to the group



And finally, members can be invited during the creation of the group.

For specific projects it may be more useful, and secure, to use chat.ukraine911.org for all communications, since this web site is reasonably protected and secured by the underlying platform.

The website also contains information from providers and donors. Donated equipment is listed under the Available Menu heading while Recipients post their requests under the Requests menu



We expect to increase the number of donated items from different donors and request as additional items under the menu items. For example under donations (Available) Giving Tree is the 1st donor, while the Ukrainian Ministry of Health's List shows under requests.

The intent currently is for experts in the various domains of material acquisition, logistics and development to use the available data, to post it and to work together with that data, the groups and the fora.

We expect to add more structure, to track all use acquisition and disposition of materials and services and to provide integration with shipping and logistics systems.
